



Reston Consulting Group was awarded a task order for the Office of Infrastructure and Platform Services (OIPS). The OIPS provides the core IT infrastructure services for approximately 2,500 users in the Office of the Secretary and its BU mission partners at the Herbert C. Hoover building (HCHB) and other ancillary locations in the National Capital Region. The hybrid firm fixed price/labor-hour task order includes a base performance period plus six one-year options with a total value of \$36,578,577.84.

This task order provides the services needed to securely operate and manage the current IT infrastructure as well as provide engineering and design expertise to develop and execute plans to migrate to a "to be state" which includes reducing the on-premises physical footprint and leverage cloud services to the extent possible. The scope of this acquisition includes project management, enterprise, infrastructure and cloud management services, asset management, vulnerability management, monitor and management capabilities, installation, move, add, change, and disposal (IMACD) services, electronic discovery (E-Discovery) and litigation holds, continuity of operations (COOP)/disaster recovery (DR), audio visual and video teleconferencing (VTC) support services, network infrastructure and operations services, communications services, and special projects.
