2021

DISQUALIFICATIONS BASED ON PERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS

Disqualification is required regarding a matter in which one of the parties is (or is represented by) someone with which an employee has a covered relationship (unless special authorization is given based on the needs of the agency.



DISQUALIFICATIONS BASED ON PAST LOBBYING AND FOREIGN AGENT ACTIVITIES

Senior politcial appointees (Presidential appointees, employees paid under the Executive Schedule, and employees with a base pay of \$176,395) who served as registered lobbyists or registered foreign agents are also barred from participating in any matter on which they lobbied or engaged in activities as a foreign agent two years before Federal appointment.
